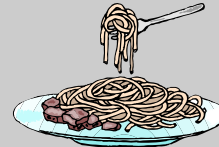

House of Horrors

You may recall that the "house of horrors" was the abortion center operated by abortionist Kermit Gosnell, who faces eight counts of murder for allegedly killing one woman and seven newborn babies who survived abortion attempts, were born alive, and then killed. The Philadelphia abortion center story made headlines earlier this year when a grand jury report revealed the filthy, blood-stained and dangerous conditions in Gosnell's center. It's a report that reads like a nightmare-while it clearly was for many of the women who went there because of their already-desperate circumstances.

In the wake of this tragedy, the Pennsylvania Legislature has been working to ensure this never happens again in their state. Already this year, the state House has passed a bill that will regulate all abortion clinics as outpatient surgery centers. This measure will hold abortion sellers to the same levels of safety and care that other medical facilities routinely provide. Please know we are continuing to fight the battle of the preborn baby every day, it is your support that enables our center to continue to help those in need!!!!
